State Attorney Ginger Bowden Madden announced that on April 21, 2021, Michael Douglas Coleman was sentenced by the Honorable Judge Linda Nobles to 10 years in State Prison for Aggravated Battery with Great Bodily Harm and a Deadly Weapon. Coleman previously entered a plea straight to the Court on this charge.

On October 28, 2018, Law Enforcement responded to a home on A Street. The Victim and Defendant had been in a verbal argument. The Defendant then retrieved a knife and stabbed the Victim in her throat. The Victim had a significant stab wound, which required her to be on life support for 3-4 days.
