PRESS RELEASE

Ginger Bowden Madden, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, announced that on August 19, 2021, Lloyd Christopher Lister was found guilty by an Escambia County jury of Home Invasion Robbery with a Firearm, False Imprisonment with a Firearm, and Grand Theft Auto.

On December 20, 2020, the Defendant entered the victim's home wearing a mask and armed with a firearm. The Defendant pointed the firearm at the victim and her daughter and demanded the victim's wallet, cellphone, computer tablet, and car keys. As the masked man continued making demands, the victim and her daughter recognized his voice to be that of the daughter's ex-boyfriend, Lloyd Lister.

The Defendant bound the victim's hands together and locked her in her bathroom. The Defendant and the victim's daughter then fled the scene in the victim's car. Two days later, the Defendant was apprehended in the victim's car by Escambia County Sheriff Office deputies.

Circuit Court Judge Linda Nobles presided over the trial and the Defendant's sentencing is set for September 28, 2021. The Defendant faces up to life in prison.
