PRESS RELEASE

Ginger Bowden Madden, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida announces that on August 24, 2021, Abron Little was sentenced to ten years in State prison followed by two years of probation. On August 5, 2021, the Defendant was convicted by an Escambia County jury of Manslaughter. Circuit Court judge W. Joel Boles presided over the trial and the sentencing of the Defendant.

On December 6, 2019, the Pensacola Police Department responded to a fight on South Palafox Street in Escambia County, Florida. After punching the victim in the face and knocking him to the ground, the Defendant kicked the victim twice before stomping on his head. Law enforcement observed a shoe impression on the victim's face matching the Defendant's shoe. The victim was later pronounced dead. The medical examiner determined the cause of death was blunt trauma.

The investigation and arrest were conducted by the Pensacola Police Department. The case was prosecuted by Assistant State Attorney Jeremiah Monahan. For further information, please contact Mr. Monahan at 850-595-4200.
